


Welcome to GreenMan Theatre! And thank you for joining us for *Murder on the DeLorean Express!*— a brand-new murder-mystery parody written and directed by Justin Vidovic, who also wrote and directed last year's popular dinner show.

We've already been busy this season, with performances of original 10-minute plays, 8 to the Bar/ista; Graveside Stories Cemetery Walks (a collaboration with the Elmhurst History Museum); and our annual storytelling program Spooky Stories and Songs of the Season plus last fall's production of Blithe Spirit by Noël Coward, a show that we originally presented back in our second season. The fun continues for our 20th anniversary season later this spring with the classic farce Charley's Aunt in May

We're already hard at work on our 21st season, reading play submissions for next summer's 8 to the Bar. We are also excited to announce that next fall we will bring *The Prom* to our stage. With music by Matthew Sklar, lyrics by Chad Beguelin, and book by Bob Martin and Chad Beguelin, *The Prom* follows four Broadway actors as they travel to a conservative town in Indiana to

help a lesbian student banned from bringing her girlfriend to the high school prom. *The Prom* was the first musical of the 2018–2019 Broadway season to be named a *New York Times* Critics Pick. Frank Rizzo, writing for *Variety*, wrote that "This cause célèbre of a show turns out to be a joyous, funny, and sweet production that should appeal to several generations of musical fans." Watch for auditions this spring!





JUSTIN VIDOVIC (Playwright and Director) — Justin previously wrote and directed Shooby Doo in That's the Way the Cookie Murders! at GreenMan Theatre and directed Monstrous Regiment and Moon Over Buffalo here as well. He also appeared at GreenMan Theatre as Sydney Carton in A Tale of Two Cities and Caliban in The Tempest. Outside of GreenMan, Justin's original plays Sheepish Love and And He Flew Over the Forest have been produced, and he is the artistic director of the theater at Prairie State College, where he is also professor of English.



BECCA EASLEY (Stage Manager) — Becca is excited to stage manage *Murder on the DeLorean Express* with such a wonderful troupe. Becca has served as a director, sound designer, assistant director, sound/light operator, and stage manager for various shows at GreenMan. Previous shows include *Hershel and the Hanukkah Goblins, Monstrous Regiment, 8 to the Bar/ista, The Tempest,* and others. 






Blithe Spirit




